The American Society for Clinical Pathology (ASCP) Foundation is awarding scholarships to those pursuing higher education in the medical laboratory sciences. Scholarships range from \$1,000 to \$5,000 and aid may be used toward certification fees, direct academic tuition, or needs-based expenses to support the student's academic career. This scholarship is made possible in part by Dr. Alvin Ring's donation to the ASCP Foundation and Cooperative Agreement NU47OE000107 from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's Division of Laboratory Systems.

Eligibility Criteria:

To foster a more inclusive and diverse laboratory workforce, this scholarship is looking for:

- Students from underrepresented populations or underserved areas within the United States of America who are seeking to serve underserved communities
- Applicants must be a student or laboratorian interested in pursuing a higher degree from a NAACLS-accredited Phlebotomy (PBT), Medical Laboratory Assistant (MLA), Medical Laboratory Technologist (MLT), Medical Laboratory Scientist (MLS), or Histotechnologist (HTL) program
